The user need

The users: State job applicants

- 251,000 people applied for CA state jobs last year
- Almost all (96%) apply online through CalCareers website

Applicants expect

- User-friendly and quick application process

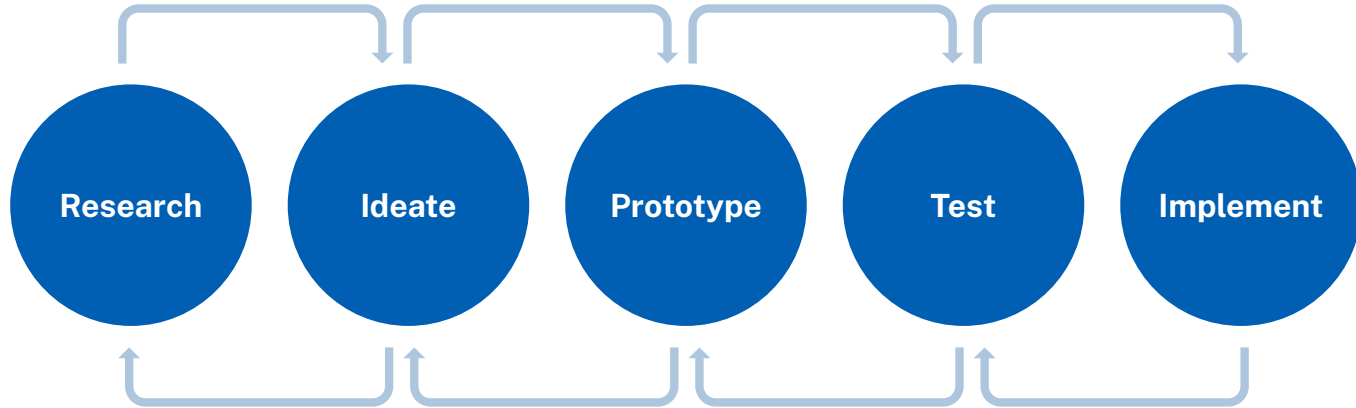
323,000 average daily visitors to ca.gov sites last year

Our human-centered design & development process

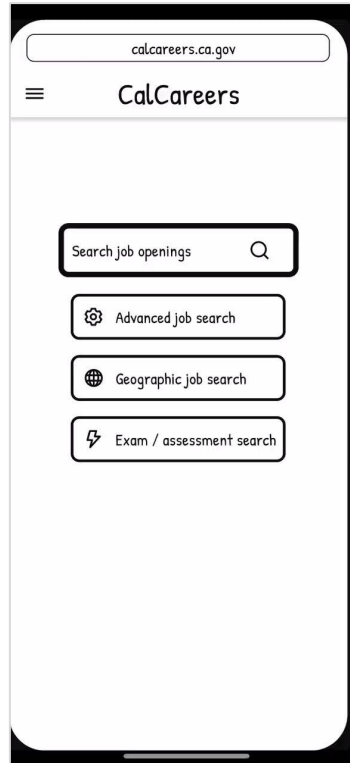


We wanted to learn

1. Whether **pre-filling information** with the mDL was helpful
2. How Californians feel about using the mDL to **apply for a job**
3. Whether our proposed user flow **meets user expectations**
4. How **secure or trustworthy** Californians think the mDL app is



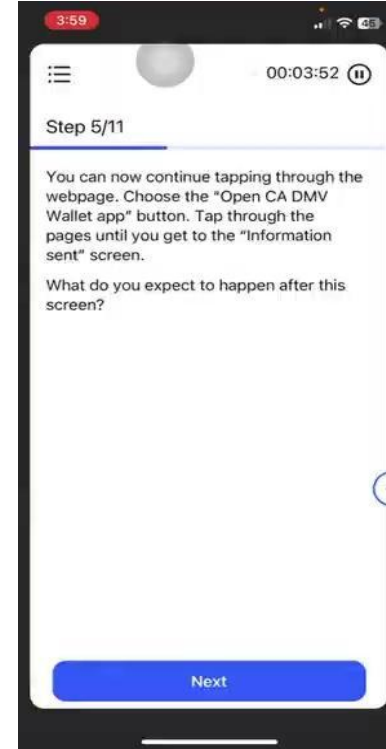
Clickable low-fidelity prototype



We tested it with everyday Californians

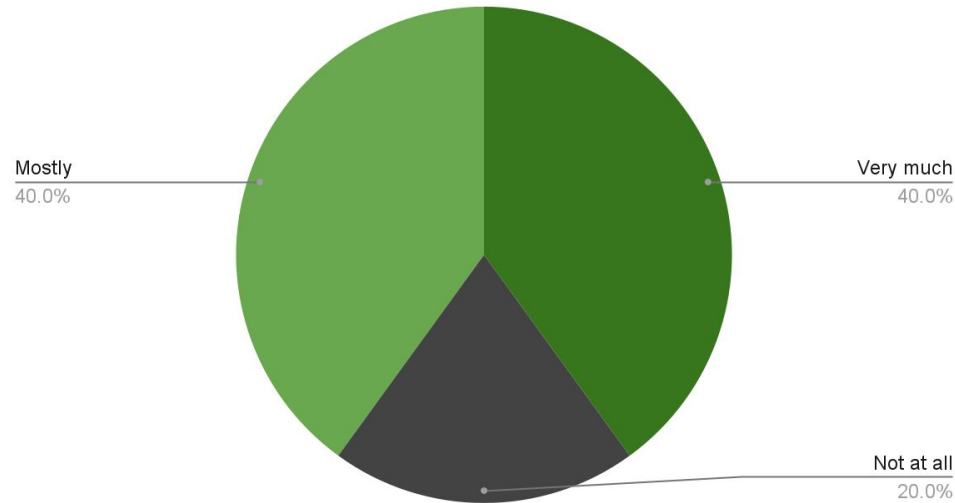
Our users

- 5 Californians with driver's licenses
- Some with the mDL app on their phone



Most users said the flow matched their expectations

How did this experience match your expectations?



Lack of consensus on pre-filling information



“ I've applied to several jobs recently and... it does save time having that information auto populate there, so very nice.

“ Even though the [DMV Wallet] app might be quicker, I prefer to put my information manually just in case that there's not a way to confirm it.

We learned

Most users found the prototype secure and trustworthy; even more with the mDL integration

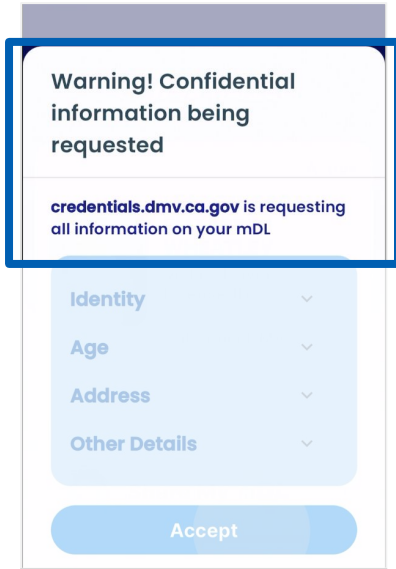

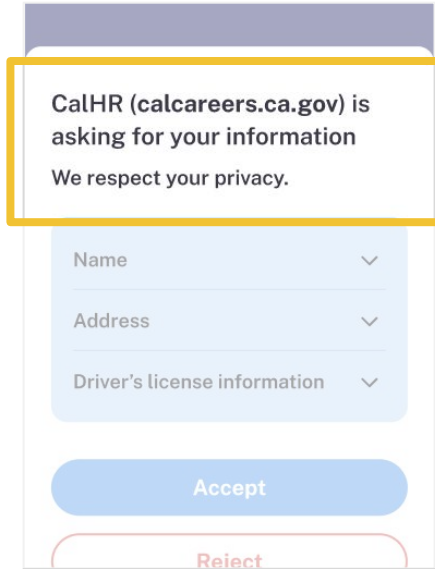

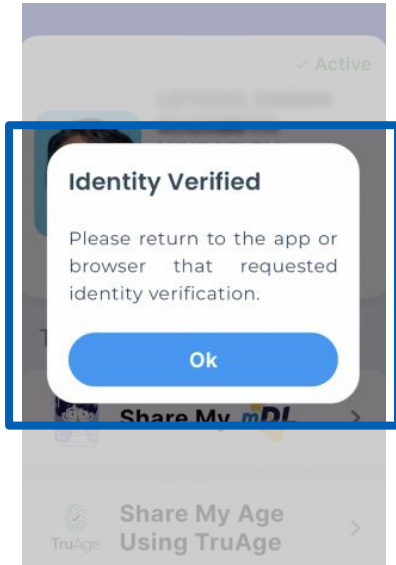


Proposed changes

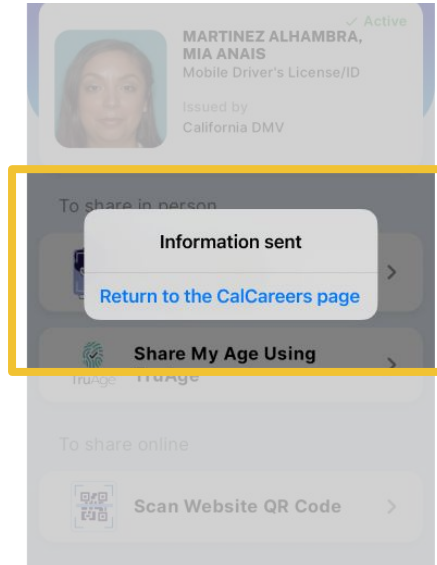
Plain language is text your audience can understand the first time they read it.

- User-focused
- Simplified
- Can build trust

Return to app that requested the Driver's License data

Proposed changes

Clarified functionality

- Our main use case is to send info, not verify identity

Clearly labelled the button with the referring app's name

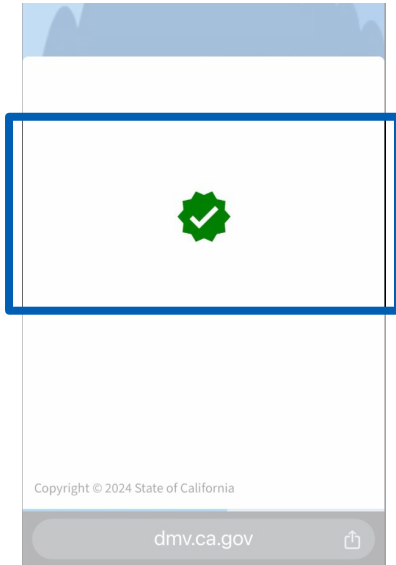
- Users are better at recognizing information than recalling which page they were on before

“ I expect the [DMV Wallet] app to have sent that information and auto populate those sections [on the CalCareers site].

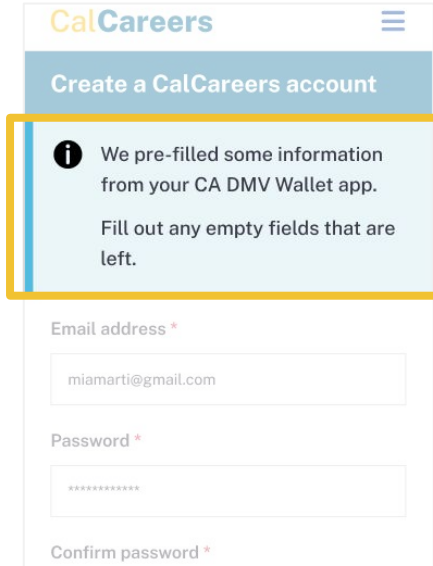

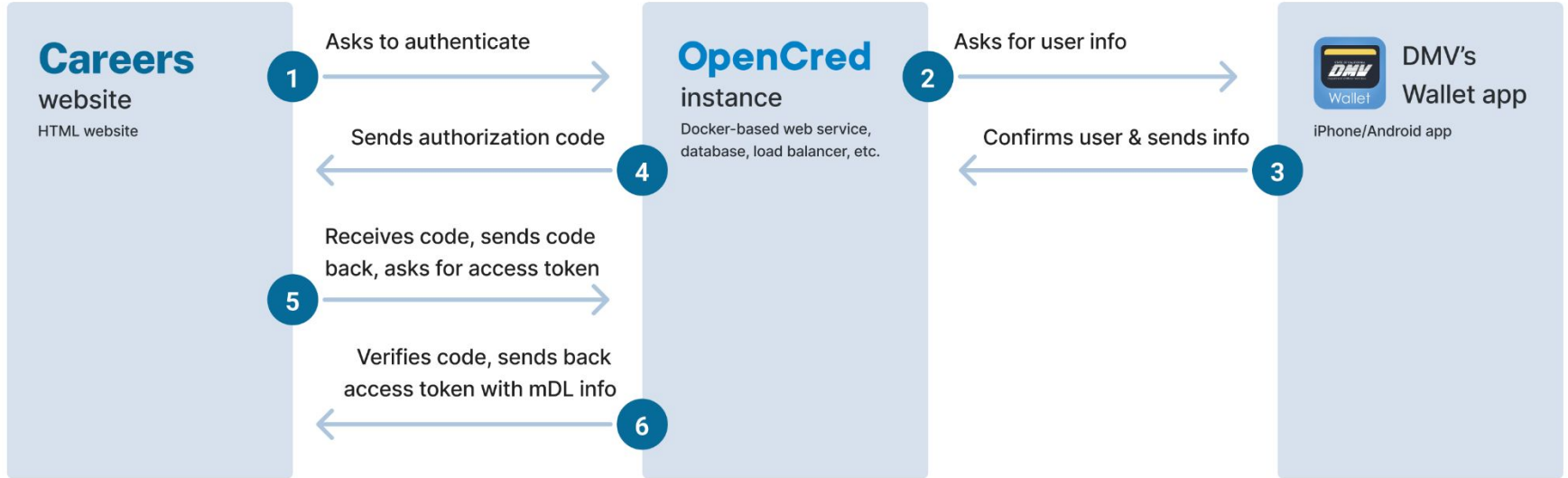

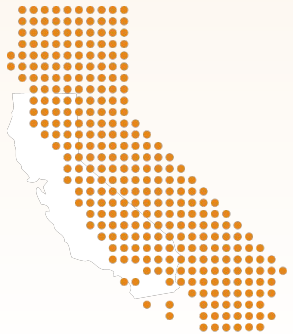
