

The users: State job applicants


- 251,000 people applied for CA state jobs last year




User testing & development process

We tested it with everyday Californians

Our users

- 5 Californians with driver's licenses
- Some with the mDL app on their phone





We learned

Most users said the flow matched their expectations

Mostly 40.0% Very much 40.0% A0.0%

How did this experience match your expectations?

We learned

Lack of consensus on pre-filling information



- 44 I've applied to several jobs recently and... it does save time having that information auto populate there, so very nice.
 - A California resident



- **44** Even though the [DMV Wallet] app might be quicker, I prefer to put my information manually just in case that there's not a way to confirm it.
 - A California resident

We learned

Most users found the prototype secure and trustworthy; even more with the mDL integration

Everything felt safe, reliable, and trustworthy, especially if they work with a DMV app.






Plain language is text your audience can understand the first time they read it.

Clarified functionality

• Our main use case is to send info, not verify identity

Clearly labelled the button with the referring app's name

• Users are better at recognizing information than recalling which page they were on before


